

Safety and Health Management Systems

Introduction

The Institute of Quarrying Australia and the quarrying industry at large recognize the importance of managing safety risks.

Safety and Health Management Systems (SHMS) are fundamental in realising the significant gains in safety performance made by larger quarrying operations in Australia. The benefits of SHMS can be achieved by smaller-scale operators, albeit that their needs differ due to the nature and scale of operations.
